NEHEMIAH: A BUILDER WHO REFUSED TO QUIT

TEXT: Nehemiah 2:18

I. BUILDERS ABOUT WHAT IS (Nehemiah 1:3-4)

A. “The wall of Jerusalem is broken down, and its gates are destroyed by fire.”

a. Notice Nehemiah's : “He sat down and wept and mourned for days.”

b. Before Nehemiah ever rebuilt the wall...He first had a broken heart.

B. The easiest thing Nehemiah could have done was it.

a. After all:

1. He wasn't living in Jerusalem.

2. The wall wasn't his responsibility.

3. He had a comfortable position in Persia.

b. Someone else could fix it - But builders never say, “Someone should do something.” Builders say, “What can I do?”

II. BUILDERS WITH (vs. 4).

A. Before Nehemiah built anything - He built something (vs. 4).

B. Notice his prayer:

a. He God (vs. 5).

b. He Sin (vss. 6-7).

c. He for Help (vs. 11).

1. Nehemiah understood:

⇒ A wall built without God is just a wall.

⇒ A life built without God is just a life.

⇒ A church built without God is just an organization.

2. Psalm 127:1 - “Unless the LORD builds the house, those who build it labor in vain.”

III. BUILDERS OTHERS TO (Nehemiah 2:17-18)

A. Nehemiah arrives in Jerusalem. He sees the damage. Then he says: “Come, let us build the wall of Jerusalem.”

a. Notice what he did not say: “You need to build.” He said: “Let us build.”

b. Nehemiah was not looking for . He was calling for .

And the people responded: “Let us rise up and build.”

c. One of the greatest verses in the book is found in: Nehemiah 4:6 “The people had a mind to work.”

1. That is why the wall was rebuilt.

2. Not because they had unlimited .

3. Not because there were no .

4. Not because everyone was .

5. They simply had willing hearts.

IV. BUILDERS THROUGH

A. The moment God's people started building...The started.

B. Nehemiah 4:1 - Sanballat mocked them. “What are these feeble Jews doing?”

a. They were .

b. They were at.

c. They were .

C. But notice their response:

a. Nehemiah 4:6 “So we built the wall.” - What a powerful statement!

b. They didn't stop to argue.

c. They didn't quit.

d. They kept building.

D. Later Nehemiah says: Nehemiah 6:3 “I am doing a great work and I cannot come down...”
